

Come and submit your work

Gasm.org is looking for pitches and submissions.

We accept pitches and submissions on sex, dating, relationships, body image and pleasure. All inquiries and submissions should be sent via email. We do not accept pitches and submissions any other way.

Please email all pitches and submissions to info@gasm.org with the subject line GASM SUBMISSION or GASM PITCH. You may send us submissions in the form of word documents or videos, in the following file formats: .doc, .docx, .txt, .mp3, .mp4, .mov, and .m4a.

We are especially interested in publishing your first person essays and short non-fiction pieces, as well as educational, fun videos and audio. If you have a technique that rocks your world, a story about body image, or a first person account of something that happened to you — we want to hear about it. Before you submit, please make sure it's in line with our mission here <http://gasm.org/about/>

If you're submitting a post or a video, please remember that:

All video submissions should be no longer than (3) three minutes. They do not need to mention Gasm.org, nor include any text over the video (TEXT IS ONLY ALLOWED IN TRANSITION SLIDES). Overall, they should be high energy and fun.

All written pieces should be no more than 1,500 words.

If this is your first submission, please include a brief, 100-word bio and headshot along with your submission.

We are willing to reprint previously published work, however, this work cannot have been published in the last year on any other website. Anything that is submitted to us cannot be reprinted anywhere else for three months. After that, the rights revert back to the author to do with the work as they please.

If we are interested in your submission or pitch, you should expect to get a response from us within two weeks.

We do accept multiple submissions, but if you're not sure that your submission is gasm-centric, we ask that you submit no more than one submission at a time.

Gasm.org is strongly committed to supporting writing, video and audio that focuses on sexuality and/or pleasure. While we don't pay for submissions at this time, we spend a lot of our times and resources promoting our contributors.

A note about publishing standards: all published pieces must be checked for spelling and grammar. We may re-edit your piece (but not your voice). Our edits are generally minimal, and we ask that you check for missing words, spelling and other grammatical errors before submitting.

We have the right to make editorial changes to your story, to make sure it matches the tone of Gasm.org. Edits are generally quite small and are more about making sure the story flows and that you sound good. We also have the right to change headlines to make them more eye-catching or relevant, and to change them for search engine optimization.

Also, please use links to back up your research. A good story is made even better when you can take it deeper.
